Career to Date

After hospital jobs and gaining my MRCP(UK) qualification I moved into full time general practice where I remained for 22 years. During this period we built a new Health Centre.

For one session a week over the 22 years I kept up working in Exeter District General Hospital, firstly in Cardiology and later in Urology running a sexual problems clinic.

For 22 years I was Principal in General practice, being Senior Partner in Okehampton for the second half of my time there.

I actively managed acute medical admissions to a busy Community Hospital. I have skills in IV fluid balance, central lines, temporary pacemaker insertion, intrapartum obstetrics and accident and emergency work. I taught undergraduates, registrars and team members.

In Okehampton I was also responsible for the continuing care of an in-patient unit for elderly confused.

I was local LMC representative from 1982-87.

In 2002 I retired from Okehampton Medical Practice to become a freelance Locum GP. I did various UK jobs and then went for nearly 2 years with my family to Australia.

In 2005 I returned from Northern Territory Australia where I had worked as a Flying Doctor and District Medical Officer to remote aboriginal communities in East Arnhem Land.

In 2007 for 2 months I worked for International SOS in Almaty, Kazakhstan

In Sept - Dec 2008 I worked as a GP in 7 different practices in New Zealand, both North and South Islands.

I have a broad range of experience working for the UK Military in various establishments in UK and overseas.

I am also giving time to work in what I feel are disadvantaged circumstances, particularly in Substance misuse, Prisons and with the Homeless.
